NOMINATION FORM

The following information is needed in order to fill out a nomination form:

- Lot information (name, breed, registration, birth date, tattoo, couture, footnote)
- Consignor information
- Membership: All consignors must be regular Michigan Cattlemen's Association members, as well as a member of your respective Michigan Breed Association.
- Nomination Fee \$100 per lot (Should you no show to the MI Beef Expo you will not receive your nomination fee back and may be subject to a bill)

CATALOG PHOTOS & FOOTNOTES

- You do not need to hire a photographer to take your photos for the catalog, but please make sure your photo is clear and has good resolution for printing. If you would like to hire a photographer, contact your breed representative for a list of local photographers.
 - NOTE: Catalog committee reserves the right to review all photos and use discretion when accepting/denying photo submissions.
 - NOTE: A limited number of additional reference photos will be used for each lot. Additional photos may be subject to additional fees.



Footnotes are included in the catalog, but we do ask for you to keep them minimal.
Example: 919J has cow power to burn! She's huge middled with lots of muscle, big footed and super sound! She'll make some really powerful bulls or females!

FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS SALE

- A nomination fee of \$100 will be required to nominate any semen or embryo lots. Any lots not selected to sell will have the deposit returned. All lots that sell will have the nomination fee added back into their settlement payment.
- Embryos and Semen need to exist and be in inventory in a safe location. If possible, sale lots should be in the possession of Great Lakes Sire Service at the time of the sale. Future flushes or semen collection will not be eligible for sale.
- The Friday Night Lights Sale is open to crossbred/commercial producers
- The Friday Night Lights sale commission is set at 10% with a \$250 cap per lot.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL SALE CATTLE CONSIGNORS

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Please refer to the current requirements for Livestock exhibited in Michigan at www.michigan.gov/mda-exhibitinfo.

OUT OF STATE CATTLE: All cattle from out of state must have interstate travel papers. Please contact the Michigan Dept. of Agriculture Animal Industry Division at 800-292-3939 for details about these requirements.

BREEDING SOUNDNESS EXAMS: Any bulls sold in the Michigan Beef Expo that are over 14 months of age at the time of sale will have satisfied a breeding soundness evaluation (BSE) using the guidelines set by the Society of Theriogenology within 30 days prior to the sale.

Bulls under 14 months of age at the time of sale will be guaranteed by the seller to satisfy the

BSE guidelines set by the Society of Theriogenology prior to 14 months of age, given that the buyer has provided adequate feed, housing, and management of the bull from the time of sale. In the event that a bull fails to mature at a rate to satisfy the BSE requirement, you shall refer to the respective National Breed Associations guidelines.

BOVINE VIRAL DIARRHEA (BVD) TEST: All sale cattle must provide negative test results and documentation for BVD and provide to the sale chairperson/s at check-in time.

RING & BUG: All display and sale bulls (any age) must have a ring or bug in their nose when out of the stall at the Beef Expo.

TIE OUTS: All animals must be double tied while in tie outs.

RFID TAGS: All cattle at the Michigan Beef Expo are required to have RFID ear tags.

CATTLE ARRIVAL: Sale and exhibit cattle may arrive beginning Thursday, February 20, 2025 after 8:00 am. For out of state exhibitors, if early arrival is necessary, please contact Scott Rancour at the MSU Pavilion, 517-432-5566. Set up of stalling areas may be done on Wednesday, February 19, 2025 between 3:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. Doors will be locked at 8:00 p.m.

LIVESTOCK JUDGING CONTEST: Consignors are required to allow for their cattle to be used for the Livestock Judging Contest if requested.

CATTLE DISPLAY AREA: Take the opportunity to make your cattle display exhibit as attractive as possible. Please be respectful of other exhibitors and guests and keep the aisles clean and keep your possessions within your assigned space. No grooming chutes are permitted in the display area. If you sprinkle your bedding with water, please use a limited amount so that it does not flow into adjacent exhibitor spaces.

TRADE SHOW: Be sure to visit the Trade Show exhibitors and let them know how much you appreciate their support. They are a vital part of the success of Michigan Beef Expo. Trade show will be open Friday 12:00 p.m.-7:00 p.m. and Saturday 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. and Sunday Morning.

HEIFER PENS: Consignors may enter up to three (3) REGISTERED, non-HALTERED females that are born on or after Oct 1, 2022. These cattle will not be shown in their respective breed show. The consignor must provide certificates of registration from a United States breed registry. Cattle will be penned in a designated area of the MSU Pavilion.

HPAI GUIDANCE: The Michigan Cattlemen's Association and Michigan State University will follow the protocols most recently established by the Michigan Department of Agriculture & Rural Development.

STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

The Michigan Cattlemen's Association or Michigan State University shall be held harmless nor liable for loss, theft, personal property damage or destruction, personal injury, financial obligation to collect or enforce collection of any monies between parties resulting from activities of The Michigan Beef Expo.

BLOCK & BRIDLE

All major event details, forms, and information will be posted on the "MSU Block & Bridle Beef Expo Show" Facebook page. Junior cattle stalling will be posted prior to junior stalling opening. Showmanship will be in the evening on Saturday, February 22 and market classes will start in the morning on Sunday, February 23.

On Friday, February 21, the junior livestock judging contest will begin at 5:30pm in the main arena. On Saturday, the skillathon contest will begin at 9am in classrooms C & D. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact one of the individuals listed below.

MOVE IN DAY - Thursday

Paperwork required on arrival (live lots) should be provided to the Breed representative. If breed representative is unavailable, turn in to the MCA show office by 5:00 p.m.

- Original copy of registration paper
- Health papers
 - Interstate travel for out-of-state entries
 - BVD test results (see requirements above)
 - BSE test results for bulls (see requirements above)
- Lot Number ID tags in ear (some breeds will send prior to arrival, others will provide at check-in)

STALLING

Stalling will be pre-assigned by each individual breed representative. Your breed rep will notify you of your stalling arrangement. Cattle should be in their stalls unless they are getting ready for their show/sale or in the show/sale arena. Bark will be provided as bedding for exhibitors.

• NOTE: No stall set up is available prior to Wednesday afternoon/evening. Stall cards for identifying animals will be provided by the breed representatives and should be hung above sale cattle by Thursday evening.

SHOW DAY - Friday

The breed representtive will create the show order for each individual breed

9:00am Cattle show by breed - Angus, Shorthorn, Hereford, Chi-Maine, Simmental, AORB

- Breed representatives will track progress of shows to ensure that lots are ring side at the appropriate time to facilitate a timely sale of animals in the posted show order.
- Upon completion of the show of your animals, be aware and ready for the champion drive during the parade of champions at 2:00 p.m or 15 minutes after the completion of the last breed show.

• NOTE: The livestock judging contest will begin at 5:30 p.m - Consignors are required to allow for their cattle to be used for the Livestock Judging Contest if requested.

SALE DAY - Saturday

The breed representtive will create the sale order for each individual breed for the Saturday Sales. These sale orders will be provided to MCA by 4:00 p.m. on Friday.

- Sale cattle should be available in the stalls beginning at 9:00 a.m.
- Breed representatives will track progress of sales to ensure that lots are ring side at the appropriate time to facilitate a timely sale of animals in the posted sale order.
- Upon completion of the sale of your animals, it continues to be the responsibility of the seller to care for the animal until the buyer has made arrangements to load out the purchased animal. Please work closely with breed representatives if arrangements are necessary for delayed load out.
- Consignors are responsible for the animals until load out and should work with breed representatives to arrange for delayed removal of sale animals if necessary.
