

2024/25 MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES Sanctioned Show Guidelines

ALL MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES SANCTIONED SHOWS MUST USE THE SHOWMAN APP FOR ENTRIES.

- 1) All sanctioned shows are required to submit a deposit of \$50 and sanction form to <u>Michigan</u> <u>Cattlemen's Association</u> before November 1, 2025. Shows with 2 rings/2 shows will be \$50 each show/ring. <u>30 DAYS AFTER your show, you must send an additional \$1 per entry per ring/show.</u>
- Newly sanctioned shows cannot be on the same dates as an established MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES sanctioned show. The established MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES show will have preference.
- 3) All shows must have their show dates reported to MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES by November 1, 2025.
- 4) All sanctioned shows will have to enter their show information in the Showman App and report all the placings through the Showman App.
- 5) All sanctioned shows must be between October 2025 and June 2026 (Unless show has already been an established sanctioned show).
- 6) All shows must be open to all Michigan residents ages 8-21 by January 1, 2026
- 7) All sanctioned shows must offer breed classes for all heifers and steers. If there are less than 3 animals showing in one breed, then the show has the option to let them show in the breed class or move them to the All-Other Registered Breed (AORB) class.
- 8) All sanctioned shows must select the top 5 market animals and the top 5 heifers. It is up to the show to decide if they get awards. MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES needs this information for point totals.
- 9) All sanctioned shows must select the Top 5 or Top 10 overall showman in each age division. Shows more than 150 must select Top 10, shows less than 149 must select top 5. It is up to the show to decide if they get awards.
- 10) ALL SANCTIONED SHOWS MUST ENTER THE PLACINGS FOR THEIR SHOW WITHIN 7 DAYS OF THE SHOWS COMPLETION. The results will then be posted on both the Showman App website and the Michigan Cattlemen's Association website
- 11) SHOWMANSHIP AGE BREAKS NEED TO BE THE SAME FOR ALL SHOWS PLEASE USE THESE BREAKS

SENIOR – 18–21 (2005–2008)

INTERMEDIATE – 15–17 (2009–2011)

JUNIOR - 12-14 (2012-2014)

BEGINNER – 8–11 (2015–2018)

- 12) Educational contests points will only count from 3 MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES sanctioned shows MI Cattlemen Classic, Michigan Winter Classic and Michigan Beef Expo OR Online options will be available.
- 13) The rule that "ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SHOW THEIR OWN ANIMALS FOR MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES POINTS TO BE COUNTED" must be listed in your show rules and must be enforced.

14) Animals that will be shown by breed and sorted this way for MI CATTLEMEN SHOWCASE SERIES points. Awards will also follow these classifications –

Angus Heifer & Steer: Purebred Angus Registration Papers **Charolais Heifer & Steer:** Purebred Charolais Registration Papers

Charolais Composite Heifer & Steer: Minimum 50% Charolais Registration Papers

Chi Heifer & Steer: All registration papers issued by the ACA Hereford Heifer & Steer: Purebred Hereford Registration Papers Maine Heifer & Steer: 75%- Maine Registration Papers (Brown)

Mainetainer Heifer & Steer: 25%-74% All Registration papers issued by the Maine Association

Shorthorn Heifer & Steer: 15/16 – Shorthorn Registration Papers

Shorthorn Plus Heifer: Minimum 50% (AR 50)- Shorthorn Plus Registration Papers

Shorthorn Plus Steer: Minimum 25% - Shorthorn Plus Registration Papers

Purebred Simmental Heifer & Steer: 7/8 or greater Simmental Registration Papers

Percentage Simmental Heifer & Steer: Minimum 50% but not greater than 7/8 Simmental

Registration Papers

ALL OTHER REGISTERED BREEDS – animals with registration papers but not listed above. Include:

Limousin Heifers & Steers Red Angus Heifers & Steers

Percentage **Shorthorn** heifers (less than ½ shorthorn)

Percentage **Simmental** steers (less than ½)

Market Heifers – Show by weight and show with Market animals for Top 5 Market Animals Commercial Heifers – Any heifer not able to be registered Crossbred Steers – Any steer not able to be registered
