FUNDING IMPORTANT RESEARCH:

MCA urged state lawmakers to fund livestock industry research. The legislature allocated \$3 million to support the industry's critical research and extension needs through the Michigan Alliance for Animal Agriculture.

EXPANDING MEAT PROCESSING:

MCA opposes burdensome regulations that jeopardize Michigan's meat processors and advocates for grant programs that promote meat processing expansion.
